Directions For Use: Complete Horse 12 is formulated for mature horses at maintenance to light work. Complete Horse 12 should be fed with hay and/or pasture; high-quality forage will typically comprise at least three-fourths of the complete diet. Feed Complete Horse 12 at a rate necessary to support the desired body condition and activity level. Use 4–6 lbs per day as a starting guideline, adjusting as necessary to meet the needs of the horse.

Change to this feed gradually over a 7- to 10-day period. Do not overfeed or offer this product on a free-choice basis. When feeding grain, divide the amount fed daily into two or more feedings. Do not feed more than 0.5% of the animal's body weight (? lb grain per 100 lbs of body weight) in grain at any one time. Maintain a regular feeding schedule. Provide fresh, clean water and adequate forage at all times. Do not allow hot, exercised horses free-choice access to water until they have cooled down.

Reminder: Feed s perishable. Store this product in a cool, dry area away from rodents and insects.

Warning: DO NOT feed any product that is spoiled, moldy, rodent or insect infested, or abnormal in appearance or odor, as it may cause illness or death. This nroduct contains supplemental copper. DO NOT feed to sheep or other copper-sensitive species.
