Textured sweet feed for mature performance horses, gestating mares and off-season stallions.

Other Guidelines	Feed along with a minimum of 12–15 lbs good-quality hay and/or pasture per day. Provide free-choice access to plain salt and water. Some horses will be able to maintain the desired body condition on less than six lbs of Super Horse Performance 12 per day.	Feed along with free- choice access to good- quality hay and/or pasture, plain salt, and water.

Directions For Use:

High-quality hay and/or pasture should make up at least half of the complete diet. Feed Super Horse 12-12 to mature performance horses, gestating mares, and off-season stallions at a level necessary to maintain the desired body condition and performance level. As a starting guideline, feed 6–8 lbs of Super Horse® 12-12 per day along with good-quality hay and/or pasture. Some horses will be able to maintain the

desired body condition on less than six lbs of Super Horse® 12-12 per day. Always feed a minimum of 10-12 lbs hay and/or pasture per day and provide free-choice access to salt and water.

Change to this feed from other equine products gradually over a 5- to 7-day period. **Do not** cut this feed with oats or other grains. **Do** not overfeed or offer this product on a free-choice basis. Divide the grain ration into two or more feedings per day. **Do not** feed more than 0.5% of the horse's body weight in grain ration at any one time. Maintain a regular feeding schedule. Provide fresh, clean water, plain salt and adequate forage at all times. **Do not** allow hot, exercised horses free-choice access to water until they have cooled down.

Caution: This product contains supplemental selenium. Do not feed this product at levels greater than recommended or in combination with other products containing supplemental selenium if the selenium concentration of the complete diet will exceed 0.03 ppm.

Reminder: Feed is perishable. Store this product in a cool, dry area away from rodents and insects.

Warning: DO NOT feed any product that is spoiled, moldy, rodent or insect infested, or abnormal in appearance or odor, as it may cause illness or death. This product contains supplemental copper. DO NOT feed to sheep or other copper-sensitive species.
